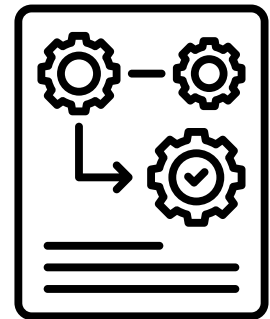
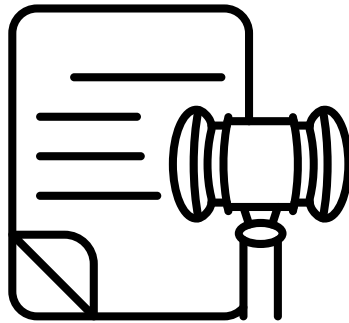
INCIDENT RESPONSE & INVESTIGATION

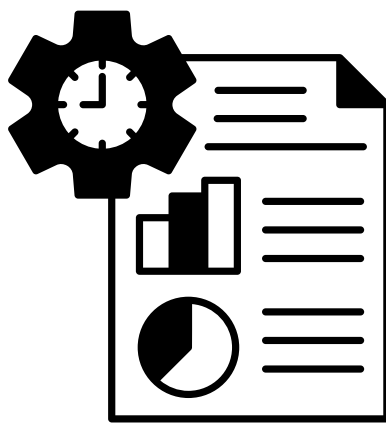
