## ABOUT THIS COURSE

This short course is designed to prepare learners to function as Scaffold Fixers in a construction and work-at-height environment. The programme develops the knowledge, practical ability, and workplace exposure needed to erect, modify, and dismantle basic (ordinary) steel scaffolding under supervision. It includes training on commonly used scaffold structures such as freestanding and tied static tower scaffolds, freestanding mobile tower scaffolds, independent scaffolds, and birdcage scaffolds, all in line with the curriculum requirements and the relevant scaffolding standard.

The purpose of the course is to move learners beyond basic scaffold support duties and prepare them for the next level of scaffold work. Learners are trained to understand the principles of basic scaffolding, interpret scaffold drawings, follow erection and dismantling procedures, apply safe modification methods, and work as part of a scaffold team. The course also emphasizes safe work-at-height practices, proper sequence of work, and the importance of complying with instructions, procedures, and safety controls at all times.

## **Introduction to the Role of the Scaffold Fixer**

- This session introduces learners to the role of the Scaffold Fixer and explains how it differs from a Scaffold Hand. Learners are introduced to the purpose of the course and the responsibility of erecting, modifying, and dismantling basic steel scaffolds under supervision in a safe and controlled manner.

## **Introduction to Basic Scaffolding**

- This topic gives learners a foundation in basic scaffolding principles. It explains what ordinary scaffolding is, where it is used, and how it supports safe work at height in construction and maintenance environments.

## **Reading and Interpreting Scaffold Drawings**

- Learners are introduced to basic scaffold drawings and how to identify scaffold types from drawings. This helps them understand the planned structure before erection or modification begins.

## **Rules and Procedures for Erecting Different Types of Scaffolds**

- This session covers the rules and step-by-step procedures used when erecting different scaffold types. The emphasis is on following correct sequence, using approved methods, and maintaining safety throughout the erection process.

**Day Two begins with a practical introduction to erecting basic scaffolds.**

- Learners are taken through realistic task conditions, work instructions, safety requirements, equipment use, and the practical application of erection methods in a controlled environment.

## **Erecting a Freestanding and Tied Static Tower Scaffold**

- Learners practice erecting a freestanding and tied static tower scaffold using the correct components, methods, and sequence. Emphasis is placed on stability, proper erection order, and working safely at height.

## **Erecting a Freestanding Mobile Tower Scaffold**

- This topic focuses on the erection of a mobile tower scaffold. Learners are shown how this structure differs from a static tower and how to erect it according to the required method and sequence.

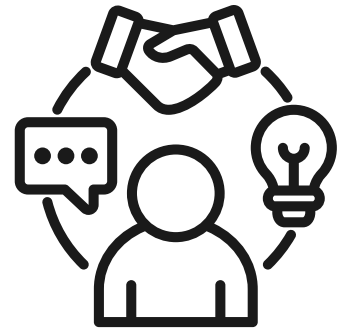
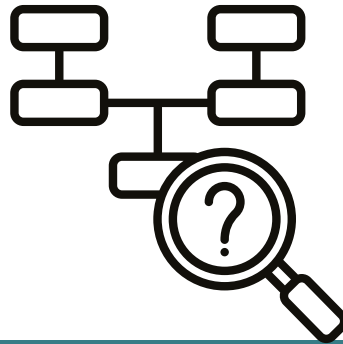
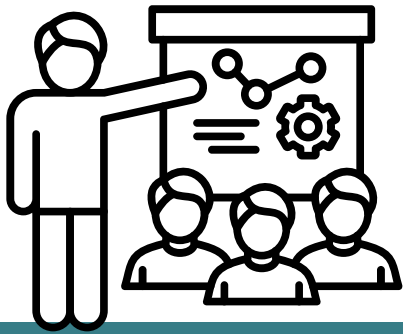
## **Erecting an Independent Scaffold and Birdcage Scaffold**

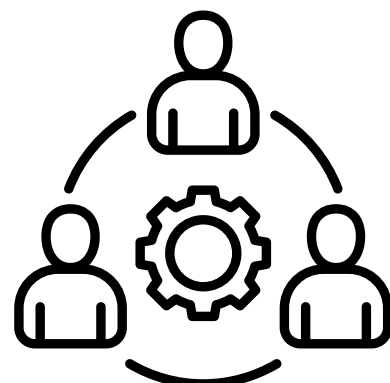
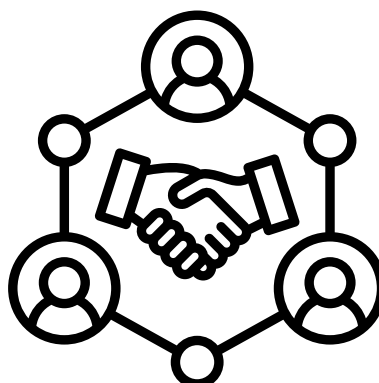
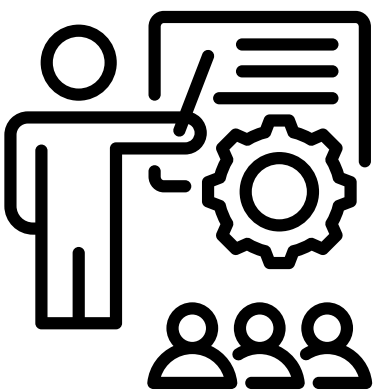
