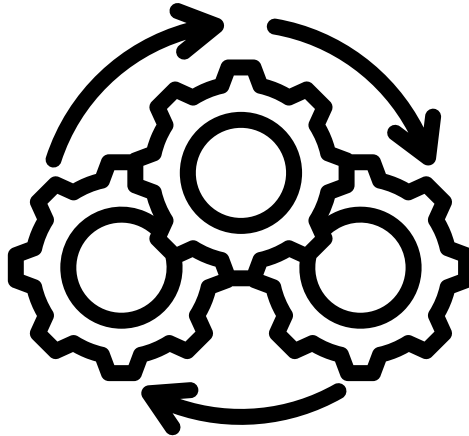
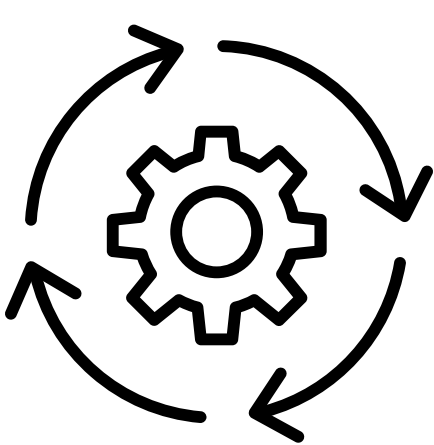
Stacking, Moving and Positioning Loads

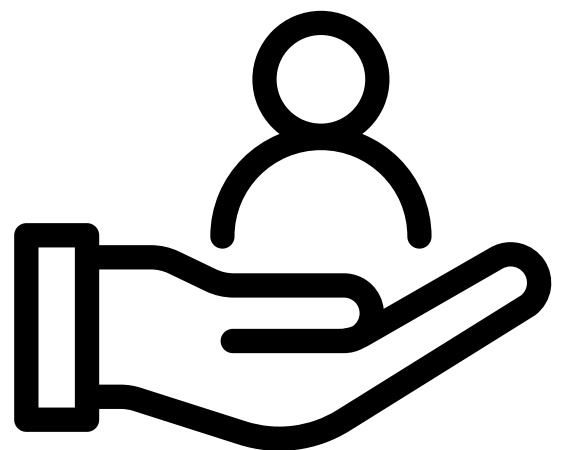
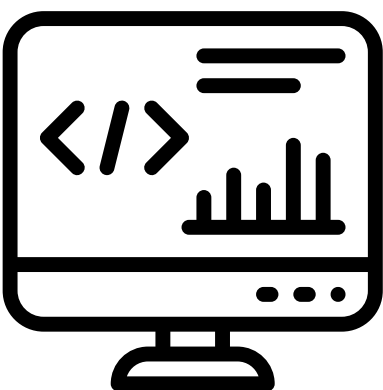
