1. Fundamentals of Fire Mobile Water Supply Operations

- Learners will understand the concepts and principles related to operating a fire mobile water supply appliance, vehicle or equipment.
- This includes the use of mobile water supply appliances when responding to emergencies or changes in on-site conditions.
- Learners will understand how mobile water supply operations support effective fire and rescue response.

Preventative Maintenance and Appliance Readiness

- Learners will understand the importance of preventative maintenance for fire appliances and mobile water supply equipment.
- This includes performing visual and operational checks on systems and components.
- Learners will understand how to identify anomalies, document inspection outcomes and report findings correctly.

Driving the Fire Appliance

- Learners will be introduced to the safe driving and operation of a fire appliance.
- This includes operating a fire appliance, backing into restricted spaces, manoeuvring around obstructions and turning within confined spaces.
- Learners will understand the importance of defensive driving techniques, restricted-clearance driving and operating fixed systems and equipment on the vehicle.

Communication During Emergency Response

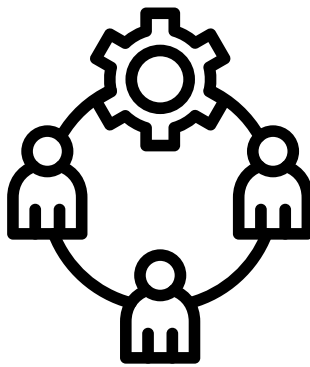
- Learners will understand how to initiate a response to a reported emergency.
- This includes sending and receiving clear, concise communication using fire department equipment and technology.
- Learners will understand the importance of effective communication during emergency response operations.
- Mobile Water Supply Preventative Maintenance
- Learners will understand how to perform visual and operational checks on mobile water supply systems and components.
- This includes following correct procedures and applying inspection techniques in line with manufacturer specifications and Standard

Operating Procedures.

- Learners will understand how maintenance checks contribute to safe, reliable and ready-to-use mobile water supply appliances.
- Mobile Water Supply Operations
- Learners will be introduced to the operation of a mobile water supply appliance at water shuttle fill and dump sites.
- This includes manoeuvring and positioning the appliance at a fill site, manoeuvring and positioning at a dump site, and establishing a water shuttle dump site.
- Learners will understand how to operate the mobile water supply appliance safely and effectively during emergency or on-site conditions.

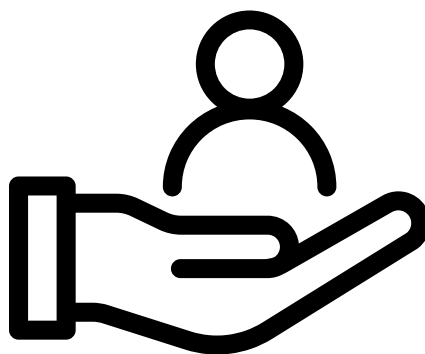
