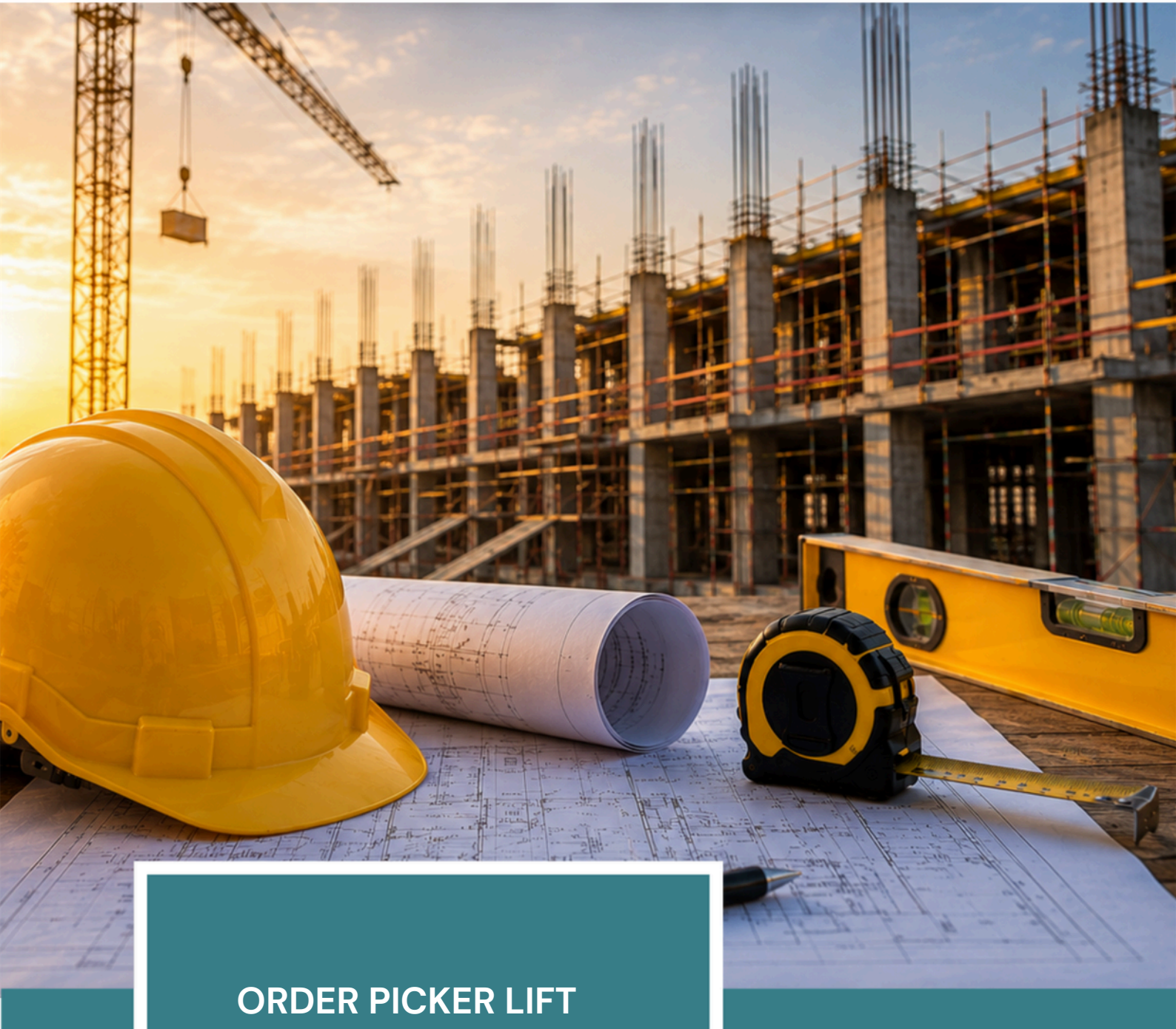

The course focuses on safe stock picking, careful manoeuvring, load handling, warehouse awareness, risk control, signage, communication and responsible operator behaviour. By completing this course, learners should be able to operate an Order Picker Lift Truck F8 with greater confidence while supporting safer and more accurate stock movement in the workplace.

SMART ZONE

First Aid Awareness

- Learners will understand the basic principles of first aid in the workplace.
- This topic explains why it is important to check the area for danger before helping someone, call for assistance, keep the injured person calm and avoid moving them unnecessarily.
- Learners will also understand the importance of reporting injuries and following company emergency procedures.

Contagious Diseases

- Learners will be introduced to basic awareness of contagious diseases in the workplace.
- This includes understanding how infections may spread through contact, poor hygiene or unsafe workplace practices.
- Learners will also understand the importance of hand hygiene, clean work areas, responsible behaviour and following workplace health procedures.

Firefighting Principles

- Learners will gain basic awareness of fire risks in material handling environments.
- This topic may include causes of fire, fire prevention, fire classes, the fire triangle and the correct use of basic firefighting equipment.
- Learners will understand why fire hazards must be reported and why emergency exits and firefighting equipment must remain accessible.

PRATICAL SKILLS

Tools, Equipment and Maintenance

- Learners will be introduced to the tools, equipment and maintenance requirements linked to Counterbalanced Lift Truck F3 operations.
- This topic explains why lift trucks must be checked, maintained and used according to company procedures and manufacturer instructions. Proper care helps prevent breakdowns, unsafe operation and damage to equipment.

Lift Truck Components

- Learners will gain an understanding of the main parts of a Counterbalanced Lift Truck F3.
- This may include the forks, mast, tyres, steering system, brakes, controls, gauges, sirens, lifting mechanisms, attachments and safety features.
- Knowing the main components helps learners complete inspections and understand how the lift truck operates.

Attachments and Safe Use

- Learners will learn about lift truck attachments and why they must be used correctly.
- Attachments must be suitable for the task, fitted properly, inspected before use and used according to manufacturer specifications. Learners will understand that incorrect attachments can affect load balance, lifting capacity and overall safety.

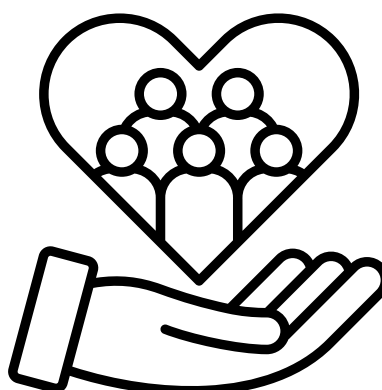
