The practical component gives learners the opportunity to conduct pre-start, start-up and operational checks, conduct set-up checks, plan and prepare for lifting, lift, move and position loads, communicate with a rigger or signal person, and secure, refuel or energise and shut down the crane safely.

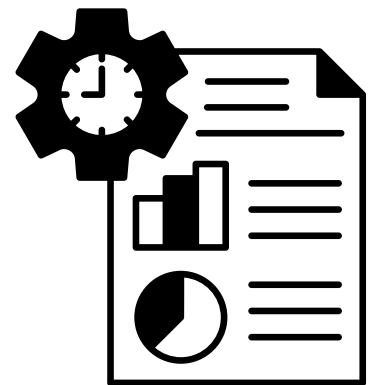
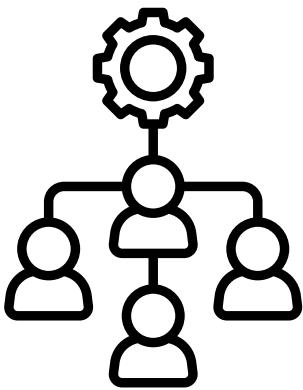
Operating, Securing and Shutdown

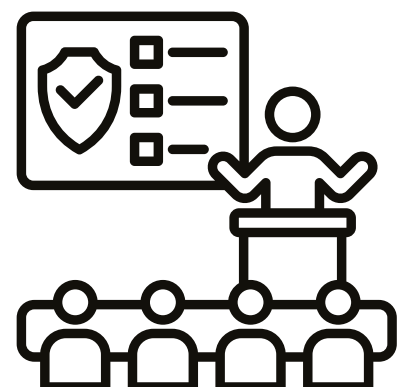
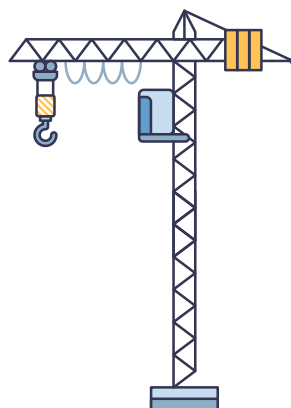
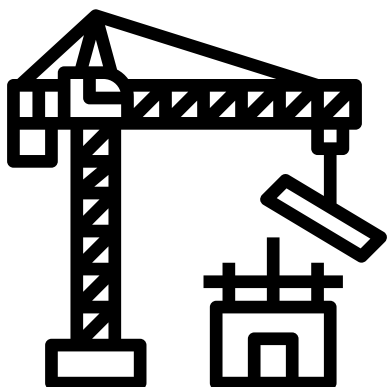
