This skills programme prepares learners to operate a Truck Mounted Crane C32 safely and correctly in the workplace. The programme focuses on raising, lowering and moving suspended loads in accordance with NCoP Code C32.

Learners will gain knowledge of safety, health, environmental, risk and quality requirements, legislation, lifting machine equipment, materials, maintenance, rigging, slinging, freight handling, communication and lifting machine operations.

The practical component gives learners the opportunity to conduct pre-start, start-up and operational checks, conduct set-up checks, plan and prepare for lifting, prepare the truck mounted crane for legal compliance to travel, lift, move and position loads, communicate with a rigger or signal person, and secure, refuel or energise and shut down the crane safely.

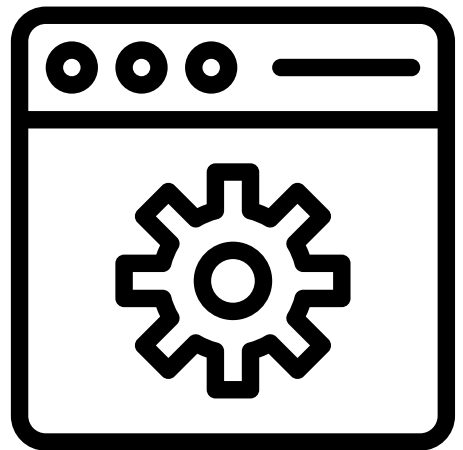
Emergency Response and Load Securement

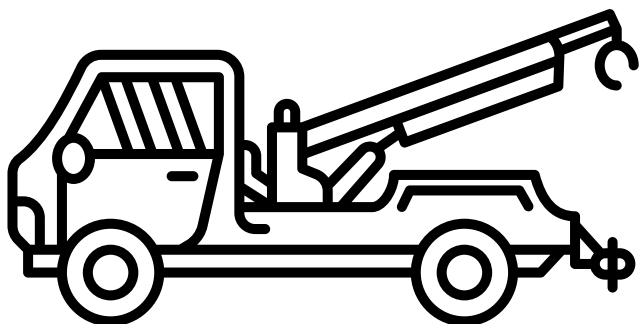
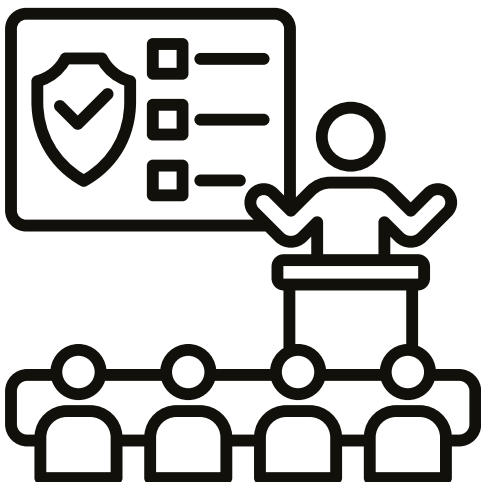
